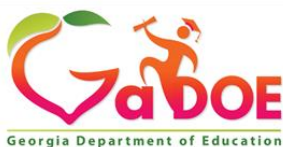

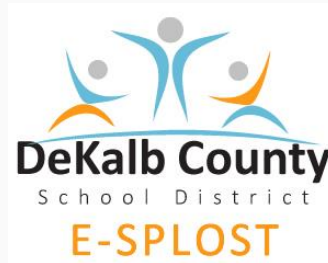

Now Available from the**

GADOE

The College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is a comprehensive school improvement, accountability, and communication platform for all educational stakeholders that promotes college and career readiness for all Georgia public school students. CCRPI reports are designed to provide information on the performance and progress of Georgia schools, districts, and the state on an easy-to-understand 100-point scale. CCRPI is Georgia's accountability system that meets state and federal accountability requirements.

The CCRPI is one of many metrics used for school-level continuous improvement planning in DCSD. Schools will begin the third-quarter CIP monitoring cycle in January. For more information on your school's CCRPI score, visit the GADOE [website](#).



School Council Construction Committees

On December 5th, the DeKalb County Board of Education approved a list of projects totaling more than \$561 million to be funded through the voter-supported [E-SPLOST V](#) and state capital outlay reimbursements from 2017-2022. To support the building improvements approved by the Board, the School Governance Team is working with the Operations Division to formalize the input of School Councils in the building design process. When a school is approved to have *significant* construction at the campus, the School Council will be informed of the general scope of the project, the project budget, and the related timeline by the Principal and Operations Division. In an open meeting, the Council will be tasked to create a subcommittee of stakeholders who can advise the Principal and the DCSD Design Team. Schools required to form a Construction



Committee will be notified of next steps in January.
